Partition Horrors Remembrance Day 10th-15th August 2022 A Report


Partition Horrors Remembrance Day is a national memorial day in India on 14 August, first declared in 2021, that commemorates the victims and sufferings of people during the partition of India.




Observance of National Unity Day 31-10-2022 Report
